Notes

- 1) Students are required to fulfill the requirements of the University Core Curriculum.
 - When some students arrive at the University of North Texas, they are “Core complete” (or partially “Core complete”).
 - Some courses from our department could be added to the LANGUAGE, PHILOSOPHY AND CULTURE category (according to the criteria of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board and following approval by administrators at the University of North Texas and the Oversight of the Core Curriculum Committee).
 - There are currently no courses with the prefix WLLC in the University Core Curriculum.
- 2) The university requires students to take at least 42 hours of advanced work (i.e., 3000/4000) as part of a program leading to a bachelor's degree. Some programs have space for advanced electives, but others do not.
